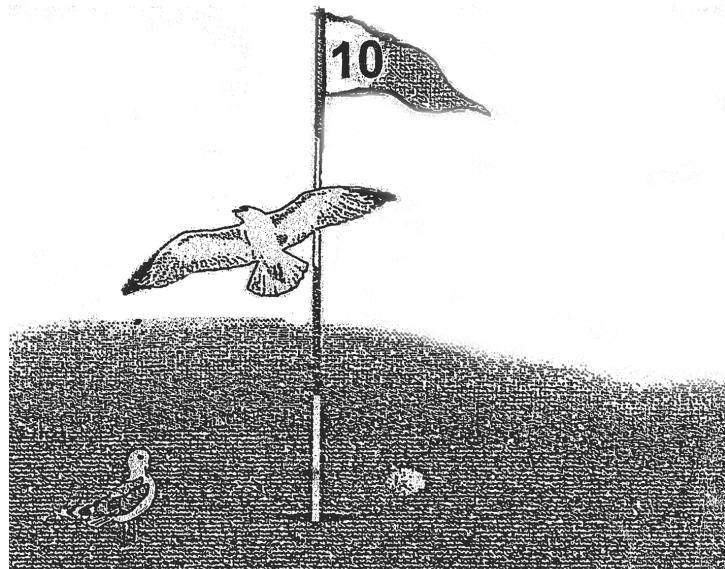

Note: to become a member of the Golf Club, you **must** be a member of the Ngunguru Sports and Recreation Society (excluding Juniors). Current Membership is \$50 per year, application forms are available at the bar or in the office.

All 9 hole and 18 hole cards must be submitted for handicapping purposes except for “off the stick” competitions.

Use of private carts on the Golf Course is permitted at owner’s risk, however will be subject to course and weather conditions. Please check prior to use. NB. Medical certificate may also be required.

Etiquette

In the interest of all, players should play without delay.
No player should play until the players in front are out of range.
Players searching for a ball should signal the players following to pass when it is apparent the ball will not be easy to find.
Play should cease until players called through are out of range.
Leave the putting green immediately the hole has been completed.
The lowest handicap player in each four should take responsibility for course etiquette.
The status of a golf club may be judged by the etiquette of its members.

Conditions of Play

Eligibility to Enter

Only financial full playing members with an official handicap can participate in Trophy and Club competitions. No handicap capping will apply for internal Club competitions except for the Ferguson Trophy. 9 hole players are eligible to play in the four mixed trophy Competitions - Stainton Trophy, Soich Plate, Finlayson Trophy, Matapouri Trophy.

Match Play

Each round must be completed on or before the date specified. Matches finishing all square must continue hole by hole until decided. Strokes are taken at the same holes as in the first 18 holes (refer NZGA Golf Club Manual).

In any matter under dispute, the decision of the committee shall be final.

Handicaps

Check your handicap before each round of play. A score card must be presented for handicap assessment after each round.

Behaviour During Play

No one should move, talk, stand close to or directly behind the ball or the hole when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke.
The Player who has the honour should, in the interest of fast play, move directly to the teeing ground and play his or her shot before marking their card.

Pace of Play

Your position on the course should be behind the group in front of you, not in front of the group behind you. Ready golf is encouraged when safe to do so.

Score Cards

One card per player or pair should be made out and returned promptly after each event. Competitor and marker must sign cards.

Tournament Scores

The purpose of the tournament scores procedure is to identify players who excel in competition well beyond their current Handicap Index. If the competition, in the judgment of the Handicap Committee, would identify such players, the Committee may announce that scores from the competition will be identified as tournament scores when posted.

Captain's Trophy, Match play Qualifying, 1 & 2 Day Open Tournaments, Top Dog Qualifying, Stroke Play Champs, National Teams & Home links Events,.

stroke with their partner's ball. One ball is then selected and play proceeds as in foursomes with the owner of the ball selected playing the third shot. Handicap allowance is half of aggregate.

FLAG COMPETITION

When a player has completed a number of strokes equal to the par of the course plus his stroke handicap, he will have finished the round. The first player to start in the competition will carry the flag and plants it on the spot where his ball lay when he finished the round. If the ball is in the rough, the flag may be planted on the fairway but not nearer the hole. If a subsequent player has not finished his round when he reached the flag, then he carries it with him and replants it when he has finished his strokes. The winner is the player who carries the flag the longest distance.

AMBROSE COMPETITION

Team stroke event, usually played by a team of four, but can be any number. Each player plays a tee shot at each tee. The captain then chooses which of these shots shall be taken. Every player except the player who's ball is taken, may then play the next shot from the selected position. This procedure of selecting the best position continues until the ball is holed. This event can be played as a gross event with each group having a spread of handicaps, or as a handicap event where a fraction of the aggregate handicap is used. For groups of four, either one is popular as the team handicap.

having the highest number of points is the winner. In scoring, after allowing for handicaps, a player who scores Par receives 2 points. For 1 over Par – 1 point. For a birdie, or 1 under par – 3 points. For an eagle, or 2 under Par – 4 points, and so on.

FOUR BALL, BETTER BALL (4BBB)

Two players play as partners each taking strokes at holes as in a Par competition. If one of the partners wins a hole with Par and the other loses it, only the half is counted as in ordinary Par competition. In a four ball handicap event, care must be taken to mark the scores of each player in separate columns headed by the initials of each player. If the scores are mixed, it is impossible for the committee to check the card and the players will be disqualified.

FOURSOMES

Two players play as partners and use one ball. The players strike off alternately from the tee and thereafter strike the ball alternately during the play at each hole. Scoring is done as for stroke round and the total is subject to a deduction of half the partners aggregate handicaps. **NOTE:** If a player incurs a penalty stroke, it does not alter the rotation of play.

CANADIAN FOURSOMES

Played as above except that both players play tee shots at every hole and afterwards continue with whichever ball they nominate.

AMERICAN FOURSOMES

Both players play tee shots at each hole, they then play a second

Golf Games – How are they played?

These notes are only intended to assist in the general concept of how various games are played. They must be read in conjunction with the rules of golf and in particular the committee shall lay down the conditions under which a competition is to be played.

STROKE PLAY

The score at each hole is entered on the score card, totaled and the player's full handicap is deducted. The player who completes the stipulated round in the fewest net strokes will be the winner.

PAR

In par play the score is entered on the card in the same way as in stroke play with the exception that where the score exceeds par for the hole, after allowing for handicap stroke, the score need not be written in. It is the custom that when a player is beaten by Par the ball shall be picked up. This helps speed up play. After entering the stroke score on the card the result is marked in the column provided with + (**plus**) sign for a win, an **0** for a half and a - (**minus**) sign for a loss. At the end of the round the + and - signs are added and the nett result is written in as so many "up" or "down" or "all square". A player is allowed their full stroke handicap and the strokes are taken at holes as indicated on the card.

STABLEFORD

The popular method of playing a Stableford competition is for the player to take strokes as in a Par competition using full handicap and to score points on the nett result at each hole. At the end of the round all points scored are added up and the player
